

# Graduate Program Scholarship Application



The \$2,000 Graduate Program Scholarship is presented each year to an NEOEA member currently enrolled in a graduate-level program.

Criteria for the \$2,000 scholarship is as follows: the recipient must be a unified NEOEA member, must be a career teacher in the teaching profession, should be in need of financial assistance, and should demonstrate a reasonable prediction of success in collegiate work. Graduate level programs must be in the licensure areas of teaching or pupil services.

Current members of the NEOEA Board of Directors are not eligible for this scholarship. In addition, NEOEA Directors are not eligible for two years after completion of service on the Board to apply or to be nominated.

One year after the scholarship is awarded, the recipient shall provide NEOEA with a statement describing his/her employment and graduate work status.

Scholarship must be submitted by Monday, April 15, 2024.
