

McConnell Music Education Scholarship Application



The Brian McConnell Music Education Scholarship was instituted in August of 2023 by the Board of Directors of the NEOEA. The scholarship was established as an annual memorial to a well-respected, past president of the North Eastern Ohio Education Association.

Criteria for the \$2,000 scholarship are as follows: the parent must be a unified NEOEA member, and the recipient must be a sophomore, junior, or a fourth-year student in a five-year program in an approved teacher education music program at an accredited Ohio college or university.

Current family members of an NEOEA Director or association staff members are not eligible for this scholarship.

One year after the scholarship is awarded, the recipient shall provide NEOEA with a statement describing his/her employment and graduate work status.

Scholarship must be submitted by Monday, April 15, 2024.
