



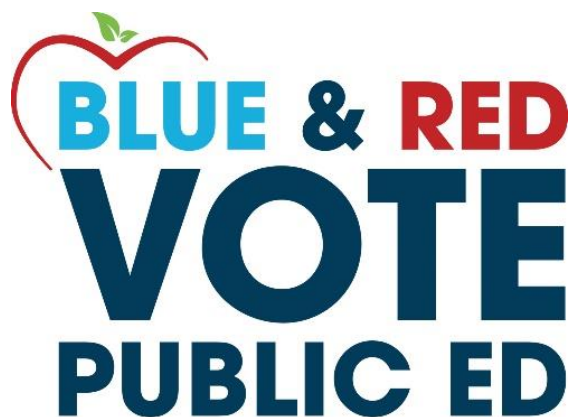

NEOEA policy 8.08b states that “Event registration constitutes a commitment to attend. Members are responsible for managing their own registrations and cancellations.
