Campaign 2026 Action



We live in a time where there are unprecedented attacks on public education from extreme politicians and special interests groups in Columbus and Washington, D.C.

In the past 4 years leaders in the Ohio General Assembly have expanded unaccountable vouchers to the tune of \$2 billion dollars a year, undercut the Fair School Funding Plan (FSFP), diminished the voice of educators on the STRS pension board, and made it more difficult for school districts to fund themselves locally through levies.

Continued State cuts to public education funding, attacks on collective bargaining, and diminishing the voice of educators will be devastating for our students, increase class sizes, end important programs, and force districts to cut staff.

To defend against these attacks and advocate for our students, educators in local unions across the State are organizing and mobilizing to protect students and public education from these attacks this election cycle. Make your voice heard by taking action to elect pro-public education, pro-labor candidates such as **Dr. Amy Acton for Governor** and **Sherrod Brown for US Senate** who will work to fairly fund public schools, support educators and students, and respect our collective bargaining rights.
